THE ALIENS REGULATIONS 1948, AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 17th day of
January, 1951

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Aliens Act, 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Aliens Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Aliens Regulations 1948* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 5, the following additional regulation :—

“ 5A. Any alien present in New Zealand as a *bona fide* visitor shall be exempt from the provisions of subsection (3) of section 6 of the said Act so long as all the following conditions apply to him, namely :

“(a) That he is not present in New Zealand for more than three months from the date of arrival at the first place of call in New Zealand of the vessel or aircraft from which he is landed :

“(b) That he is in possession of a ticket or other document authorizing him to embark on a vessel or aircraft departing from New Zealand not more than three months after the date of arrival at the first place of call in New Zealand of the vessel or aircraft from which he is landed ; and

“(c) That he is not present in New Zealand at any time after the departure from New Zealand of the vessel or aircraft in which he is authorized to embark as aforesaid.”
