ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 3rd day of August 1981

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Arms Act 1958, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Arms Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 10, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Arms Regulations 1959* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 24th day of August 1981.

2. Fee for issue of copy of licence, permit, or certificate increased—Regulation 36 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Arms Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 9) is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$4.00", and substituting the expression "\$5.50".

3. Fees increased—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Third Schedule (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Arms Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 9), and substituting the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

4. Revocation—The Arms Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 9 are hereby consequentially revoked.
