



## THE ARMS REGULATIONS 1959, AMENDMENT NO. 9

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 29th day of October 1979

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Arms Act 1958, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Arms Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Arms Regulations 1959\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Fee for issue of copy of licence, permit, or certificate increased**—Regulation 36 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 10 of the Arms Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 8) is hereby amended by omitting the expression “\$2.50”, and substituting the expression “\$4.00”.

**3. Fees increased**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Third Schedule (as substituted by regulation 12 of the Arms Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 8), and substituting the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

**4. Revocation**—Regulations 10 and 12 of, and the Second Schedule to, the Arms Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 8 are hereby consequentially revoked.

\*Where a dealer's licence is issued to take effect at any time between the 1st day of October in any year and the 31st day of March in the following year, the fee for the licence shall be half that prescribed above in respect of that kind of licence."
