PURSUANT to the Architects Act 1963, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Architects Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Architects Regulations 1964* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Registration fee—(1) Regulation 6 of the principal regulations (as amended by section 7 of the Decimal Currency Act 1964) is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (1) the expression “\$21”, and substituting the expression “\$25”.

(2) This regulation shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1975.

3. Practising fee—(1) Regulation 6 of the principal regulations (as so amended) is hereby further amended by omitting from subclause (3) the expression “\$6.30”, and substituting the expression “\$10”.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of regulation 6 (3) of the principal regulations (as amended by subclause (1) of this regulation), the fee payable for any practising certificate issued in respect of the year ending with the 31st day of March 1975 shall be \$6.30.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase two fees prescribed by the Architects Regulations 1964.

The fee payable on an application for registration as an architect is increased from \$21 to \$25. This increase comes into force on 1 April 1975.

The fee for an annual practising certificate is increased from \$6.30 to \$10 although the fee payable for a practising certificate issued in respect of the current year (which ends with 31 March 1975) will remain at \$6.30.
