

# THE ARCHITECTS REGULATIONS 1964, AMENDMENT NO. 3

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 13th day of October 1980

Pursuant to the Architects Act 1963, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Architects Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Architects Regulations 1964\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) Subject to regulation 2 (2) of these regulations, these regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification

in the Gazette.

2. Practising fee—(1) Regulation 6 (3) of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 3 (1) of the Architects Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 2) is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$15", and substituting the expression "\$30".

"\$15", and substituting the expression "\$30".

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of regulation 6 (3) of the principal regulations (as amended by subclause (1) of this regulation), the fee payable for any practising certificate issued in respect of the year ending with the 31st day of March 1981 shall be \$15.

3. Revocation—Regulation 3 of the Architects Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 2 is hereby consequentially revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the fee payable by an architect for an annual practising certificate. The fee is increased from \$15 to \$30 although the fee payable for a practising certificate issued in respect of the current year (which ends with 31 March 1981) remains at \$15.
