PURSUANT to section 18 (4) of the Administration Act 1969, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Administration (Fees) Regulations 1987.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1987.

2. Fee payable for certificates of administration—The fee payable to a Registrar of the High Court for the issue of a certificate of administration under section 18 of the Administration Act 1969 shall be \$10.

3. Revocation—The Administration (Fees) Regulations 1981* are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase from \$5 to \$10 the fee payable for the issue of a certificate of administration under section 18 of the Administration Act 1969.
