**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At Wellington this 2nd day of June 1992

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 18 (4) of the Administration Act 1969, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Administration (Fees) Regulations 1992.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1992.

**2. Fees payable for certificate of administration**—The fee payable to a Registrar of the High Court for the issue of a certificate of administration under section 18 of the Administration Act 1969 shall be \$15.

**3. Goods and services tax included**—The fee prescribed by these regulations is inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

**4. Revocations**—(1) The Administration (Fees) Regulations 1987\* are hereby revoked.

(2) The Fees Regulations 1987\* are hereby amended by revoking so much of the Schedule as relates to the Administration (Fees) Regulations 1987.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 1992, increase from \$10 to \$15 the fee payable for the issue of a certificate of administration under section 18 of the Administration Act 1969. The fee prescribed is inclusive of goods and services tax.
