PURSUANT to section 167 of the Accident Rehabilitation and Compensation Insurance Act 1992, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Accident Rehabilitation and Compensation Insurance (Social Rehabilitation-Attendant Care) Regulations 1992, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Accident Rehabilitation and Compensation Insurance (Social Rehabilitation-Attendant Care) Regulations 1992* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January
- 2. Application—Regulation 3 (1) (b) of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting the word "January", and substituting the word "July":

(b) By omitting the words "31st day of December 1992", and substituting the words "30th day of June 1993".

(2) Regulation 3 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "had a written application for attendant care processed by the Corporation", and substituting the words "made a written application to the Corporation for attendant care".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations postpone, from 1 January 1993 to 1 July 1993, the date on which the principal regulations will apply to persons for whom any payment for attendant care under section 80 (8) of the Accident Compensation Act 1992 has been continued until 30 June 1993 by virtue of section 149 of the Accident Rehabilitation and Compensation Insurance Act 1992 (as amended by section 2 of the Accident Rehabilitation and Compensation Insurance Amendment Act (No. 2) 1992).

In addition, the presumption that any such person has had an application processed by the Commission is removed. The presumption will be that the person has made an application.
