PURSUANT to section 167 of the Accident Rehabilitation and Compensation Insurance Act 1992, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Accident Rehabilitation and Compensation Insurance (Motor Vehicle Premiums) Regulations 1994, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Accident Rehabilitation and Compensation Insurance (Motor Vehicle Premiums) Regulations 1994* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 15th day of December 1995.

2. Interpretation—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definition of the term “EB class vehicle”, and substituting the following definition:

“‘EB class vehicle’ means a vehicle of a kind described in the Schedule to the Transit New Zealand (Exempted Vehicles) Order 1995†:”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 15 December 1995, substitute a new definition of “EB class vehicle”.

At present an EB class vehicle is defined as a vehicle of a kind described in the First Schedule to the Motor Spirits Duty Refund Regulations 1978.

Those regulations have been revoked and the First Schedule has been replaced by the Transit New Zealand (Exempted Vehicles) Order 1995.
