THE ANIMAL REMEDIES (FEES) REGULATIONS 1968

PURSUANT to the Animal Remedies Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Animal Remedies (Fees) Regulations 1968.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Interpretation—In these regulations “the Act” means the Animal Remedies Act 1967.

3. Licence fees—Every application for a licence for an animal remedy made pursuant to—

- (a) Section 19 of the Act for a full licence; or
- (b) Section 24 of the Act for a provisional licence; or
- (c) Section 25 of the Act for the renewal of a licence—

shall be accompanied by a fee of \$5; but no fee shall be payable for an application made pursuant to subsection (3) and subsection (4) of section 24 of the Act for the purpose of converting a provisional licence into a full licence.

4. Advertisement fee—Every advertisement for an animal remedy submitted for approval pursuant to subsection (1) of section 41 of the Act after the lodging of an application for a licence in respect of the remedy shall be accompanied by a fee of \$1.

5. Analysis fee—Any request by a buyer for an analysis of an animal remedy, made pursuant to subsection (1) of section 45 of the Act, shall be accompanied by a fee of \$20.

6. Revocation—(1) Regulation 23 of the Stock Remedies Regulations 1947* is hereby revoked.

(2) Regulation 6 of the Stock Remedies Regulations 1947, Amendment No. 3†, is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations specify the fees to be paid by applicants for licences under the Animal Remedies Act 1967, and for the approval under section 41 of that Act of advertisements and the carrying out of analyses under section 45 of that Act.
