**THE ANIMAL REMEDIES (FEES) REGULATIONS 1968,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 21st day of June 1976

PURSUANT to the Animal Remedies Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Animal Remedies (Fees) Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Animal Remedies (Fees) Regulations 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1976.

2. Licence fees—Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “\$5”, and substituting the expression “\$30”.

3. Advertisement fee—Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “\$1”, and substituting the expression “\$5”.

4. Analysis fee—Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “\$20”, and substituting the expression “\$100”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the prescribed fees under the Animal Remedies Act as follows—

- (a) A licence application fee is increased from \$5 to \$30.
- (b) The fee to accompany an application for approval of an advertisement under section 41 (1) is increased from \$1 to \$5:
- (c) The fee for an analysis of an animal remedy under section 45 is increased from \$20 to \$100.
