PURSUANT to the Animal Remedies Act 1967, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Animal Remedies Regulations 1980, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Animal Remedies Regulations 1980* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Requirements as to premises—Regulation 21 (1) (c) of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Animal Remedies Regulations 1980, Amendment No. 2) is hereby amended by omitting the words “Drainage and Plumbing Regulations 1978”, and substituting the words “building code set out in the First Schedule to the Building Regulations 1992”.

3. Board may prescribe code of standards—Regulation 35 (1) (d) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the word “construction,”, and also the words “the structural alteration of any such premises,”.
