

# THE ANIMAL REMEDIES (FEES) REGULATIONS 1998, AMENDMENT NO. 1

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 65 of the Animal Remedies Act 1967, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Animal Remedies (Fees) Regulations 1993, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Animal Remedies (Fees) Regulations 1993\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) Except as provided in subclause 3 of this regulation, these regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
  - (3) Regulation 3 of this regulation shall come into force on 1 July 1995.
- 2. Licence fee—Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from paragraph (a) the expression "\$1,968.75", and substituting the expression "\$2,812.50":
- (b) By omitting from paragraph (b) the expression "\$2,250", and substituting the expression "\$3,150".
- **3. Annual fee**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 13, and substituting the following regulation:
- "13. The holder of a licence (whether full or provisional) to manufacture or import an animal remedy shall in every year (commencing on the 1st day of July) during which the licence continues in force pay to the Board a fee of \$337.50—
  - "(a) In full, within 1 month of receiving from the Registrar written notice to do so; or
  - "(b) In such instalments as the Registrar may specify in a written notice."

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette, amend the Animal Remedies (Fees) Regulations 1993 by increasing the fee payable for a provisional licence from \$1,968.75 to \$2,812.50 and for all other licences from \$2,250 to \$3,150. The annual fee for all licence holders is increased from \$263.25 to \$337.50. The annual fee can now be paid in instalments. All fees are inclusive of goods and services tax.
