THE APIARY REGISTRATION SUSPENSION EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1942

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Apiary Registration Suspension Emergency Regulations 1942.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Apiary Registration Regulations 1937* made under the Apiaries Act, 1927, or in any certificate of registration issued under those regulations in respect of an apiary, the registration of every apiary effected under those regulations and in force on the 31st day of October, 1942, or thereafter effected shall, unless sooner cancelled or ceasing to be operative in accordance with the provisions of the said regulations, continue in force until the 31st day of October, 1947, or until the 31st day of October next after the date on which these regulations cease to be in force, whichever date be the later.
