ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 30th day of July 1962

PURSUANT to the Civil Aviation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Aeronautical Research Scholarship Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Aeronautical Research Scholarship Regulations 1959* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Subclause (1) of regulation 6 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "of £400", and substituting the words "of £520".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations increase the annual emolument for a scholarship under the principal regulations from £400 to £520.
