**AMENDING REGULATIONS UNDER THE CHRISTCHURCH
TRAMWAY DISTRICT ACT, 1920.**

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.

Date on which the regulations were made : 12th day of August, 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette* : 20th day of August, 1936.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Christchurch Tramway District Act, 1920 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby amend the regulations made under the said Act on the 1st day of September, 1930, and published in the *Gazette* on the 4th day of the same month (hereinafter termed "the principal regulations"),* in the following manner :—

1. Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is amended by the deletion of the proviso thereto.

2. Regulation 10 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following substituted therefor :—

The following abbreviations may be used for the purpose of Regulation 9 hereof :—

Abbreviation " C " means Central Subdistrict :

Abbreviation " A " means Avon Subdistrict :

Abbreviation " H " means Heathcote Subdistrict :

Abbreviation " R " means Riccarton Subdistrict :

Provided that the above information respecting abbreviations shall be prefixed to every list or part thereof in which any of the said abbreviations are used.
