ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 17th day of August 1981

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Air Services Licensing Act 1951, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Air Services Licensing Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Air Services Licensing Regulations 1952\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. New Second Schedule to principal regulations**—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 3 (1) of the Air Services Licensing Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 7), and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Regulation 3 of, and the Schedule to, the Air Services Licensing Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 7, are hereby revoked.
