HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Air Services Licensing Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Air Services Licensing Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Air Services Licensing Regulations 1983*.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Returns to be made by licensee—Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “audited by a

chartered accountant in public practice”, and substituting the words “prepared by a member of the New Zealand Society of Accountants”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations remove the requirement that the closing balance sheet and profit and loss account supplied annually by licensees to the Air Services Licensing Authority must have been audited by a chartered accountant in public practice. The new requirement is that they must have been prepared by a member of the New Zealand Society of Accountants.
