Pursuant to the Arms Act, 1920, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Air Training Corps Arms Regulations 1944.
- 2. The Air Board may authorize any officers, non-commissioned officers, and Cadets of the Air Training Corps to carry and have in their possession firearms belonging to the Crown, and ammunition required for the same.
