PURSUANT to section 162 (2) of the Education Act 1989, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Auckland University of Technology (Establishment) Order 1999.
 - (2) This order comes into force on 1 January 2000.
- **2. Auckland University of Technology established**—The Auckland University of Technology is established.
- **3. People who are to constitute university**—The people who are to constitute the Auckland University of Technology are—

- (a) Its Council, the professors emeriti, the academic staff, and the general staff; and
- (b) Its graduates and students; and
- (c) Such other people or classes of people as the Council from time to time determines.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order establishes the Auckland University of Technology. It comes into force on 1 January 2000, and should be read with the Auckland Institute of Technology Disestablishment and Incorporation into Auckland University of Technology Order 1999.
