PURSUANT to section 24 (2) of the Animals Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Animals (Equine Viral Arteritis) Order 1989.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Equine Viral Arteritis added to Second Schedule diseases—The Second Schedule to the Animals Act 1967 is hereby amended by inserting, after the item "Equine Infectious Anaemia", the item "Equine Viral Arteritis".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force 28 days after notification in the *Gazette*, adds equine viral arteritis to the diseases specified in the Second Schedule to the Animals Act 1967.
