Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Animal Welfare (Forms) Amendment Regulations 2006.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 10 October 2006.

3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the Animal Welfare (Forms) Regulations 1999.

4 Schedule amended

- (1) Form 2 of the Schedule is amended
 - by omitting "Name:" and substituting "Full name:"; and
 - by "Address:" and substituting "Full (b) omitting address:".
- Paragraph 12(a) of the summary of rights in form 2 of the (2) Schedule is amended by inserting ", or provide particulars of the reminder notice for filing," after "MAF may file a copy of the reminder notice".

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the infringement notice prescribed by the Animal Welfare (Forms) Regulations 1999 to-

- clarify name and address requirements; and
- reflect changes (made by the Summary Proceedings Amendment Act 2006) to the summary procedure for infringement offences in section 21 of the Summary Proceedings Act 1957.
