**THE AGRICULTURAL WORKERS (ORCHARDS AND VINEYARDS) ORDER 1971, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 3rd day of July 1972

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to Part III of the Agricultural Workers Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. **Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Agricultural Workers (Orchards and Vineyards) Order 1971, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Agricultural Workers (Orchards and Vineyards) Order 1971\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 20th day of March 1972, and shall continue in force until the 30th day of November 1972, and thereafter until a further order is made in substitution for the principal order.

2. **Wages of permanent workers**—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by revoking clause 3, and substituting the following clause:

“3. The minimum rates of wages for permanent workers shall be as follows:

Female workers of 20 years of age and over .....	33.83

Under 16 years .....	16.33
16 years and under 17 years .....	19.90

19 years and under 20 years .....	32.57.”

**3. Wages of casual workers**—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by revoking clause 4, and substituting the following clause:

“4. The minimum rates of wages for casual workers shall be as follows:
