## AMENDING WARRANT DEFINING RIVER, EXTENDED RIVER, AND EXTREME LIMITS

1. Pursuant to section 189 of the Shipping and Seamen Act, 1908, I, William Stanley Goosman, Minister of Marine, hereby amend the Warrant dated the 7th day of November, 1949, defining river, extended-river, and extreme limits\* as follows :---

(a) By omitting from the third column of the Schedule to that Warrant headed "Extended-river and Partially Smoothwater Limits" the words defining the seasonal limits of the Ports of Bay of Islands, Mangonui, and Whangaroa, and substituting in each case the following words :---

"Seasonal: For vessels engaged in deep sea sports fishing only: From 1st May to 31st October: Inside lines commencing at North Cape Light, thence  $117^{\circ}$  to a position  $000^{\circ}$ , 13 miles from Cape Brett Light, thence the arc of a circle of 13 miles radius East and South to the mainland. From 1st November to 30th April: Inside lines commencing at North Cape Light, thence  $112^{\circ}$  to a position  $000^{\circ}$ , 20 miles from Cape Brett Light, thence the arc of a circle of 20 miles radius East and South to the mainland.":

(b) By inserting in that Schedule, after the definition of the river, extended river, and extreme limits of the Port of Tauranga, the following definition of the river, extended river, and extreme limits of the port of Te Kaha :---

".Port.	River and Smooth-water Limits.	Extended-river and Partially Smooth-water Limits.	Extreme Limits.
Te Kaha	Inside an arc of a circle of 5 miles radius with Te Kaha Point as centre	Inside lines commencing at Opape Point, thence 000°, 5 miles; thence 032°, 14 miles; thence 051°, 19 miles; thence 133° to Cape Runaway	Nil."

2. Pursuant to section 189 of the Shipping and Seamen Act, 1908, I, William Stanley Goosman, Minister of Marine, hereby consequentially amend the Warrant dated the 6th day of November, 1950 (which amended the Warrant referred to in clause 1 hereof), by revoking paragraph (a).
