



**THE AGRICULTURAL WORKERS (ORCHARDISTS)
EXTENSION ORDER 1961, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 31st day of October 1962

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Agricultural Workers Act 1936, and after submission by the Minister of Labour to the organisation of the workers of the class affected and to the organisation of their employers of the proposal to vary the Agricultural Workers (Orchardists) Extension Order 1961 as hereinafter appears, and after approval in all material particulars by the said organisations of the provisions herein contained, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited at the Agricultural Workers (Orchardists) Extension Order 1961, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Agricultural Workers (Orchardists) Extension Order 1961* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

(2) Except as provided in subclause (3) of this clause, this order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette* and shall continue in force until the 30th day of September 1963 and thereafter until a further order is made in substitution therefor.

(3) The provisions of this order relating to rates of wages shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October 1962.

2. The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by revoking clause 3, and substituting the following clause:

"3. The minimum rate of wages for permanent workers shall be as follows:

3. The Schedule to the principal order is hereby further amended by revoking clause 4 and substituting the following clause:

4. Subclause (2) of clause 16 of the Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting the symbols "£1 15s.", and substituting the symbols "£2 5s.";

(b) By omitting the symbols "£1", and substituting the symbols "£1 10s.".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order amends the Agricultural Workers (Orchardists) Extension Order 1961, consequent upon the general wage order made by the Court of Arbitration on 4 July 1962, by increasing wage rates payable to agricultural workers employed in orchards as from 1 October 1962. It also increases the seasonal subscription payable by workers required to be members of the organisation of workers.
