## THE AGRICULTURAL WORKERS WAGES ORDER 1955

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 8th day of February 1955

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. K. J. HOLYOAKE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Agricultural Workers Act 1936, and having regard to the prices for the time being fixed under section 16 of the Dairy Products Marketing Commission Act 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Agricultural Workers Wages Order 1955.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 18th day of November 1954, and shall continue in force until the 31st day of July 1955, and thereafter until a further order is made in substitution therefor.

2. (1) Subject to the provisions of this clause, the following shall be the minimum rates of wages payable under the said section 14 to agricultural workers employed on dairy farms:

(a) For workers under the age of 17 years	4	5	3
(b) For workers of the age of 17 years but under the age of 18 years	5	5	9
(c) For workers of the age of 18 years but under the age of 19 years	6	8	0
(d) For workers of the age of 19 years but under the age of 20 years	7	9	3
(e) For workers of the age of 20 years but under the age of 21 years	8	9	6
(f) For workers of the age of 21 years and upwards	9	10	0

(2) The above rates shall be deemed to include allowance for work done at week-ends and on holidays as part of the normal week's work.

(3) In the case of those workers who are not provided with board and lodging by their employers the aforesaid rates shall be increased by £1 16s. a week.
