

THE AGRICULTURAL WORKERS WAGES ORDER 1975

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to Part III of the Agricultural Workers Act 1962, and section 7 of the Age of Majority Act 1970, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Agricultural Workers Wages Order 1975.

- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette and shall continue in force until 31 December 1975 and thereafter until a further order is made in substitution for it.
- 2. Wages rates—(1) Subject to the provisions of this clause, the following shall be the minimum weekly wages payable to agricultural workers employed on dairy farms—

(a) For workers under the age of 17 years	32.29
(b) For workers of the age of 17 years but under the

(c) For workers of the age of 18 years but under the

(d) For workers of the age of 19 years but under the

(2) The wages hereby prescribed shall be deemed to include allowance for work done at weekends and on holidays as part of the normal week's work.

(3) In the case of those workers who are not provided with board and lodging by their employers the wages aforesaid shall be increased by \$4.25 a week.

3. Casual workers—The following shall be the minimum rates of wages payable to casual workers:

- 4. Revocations—(1) The Agricultural Workers Wages Order 1960* is hereby revoked.
- (2) So much of the Second Schedule to the Age of Majority Act 1970 as relates to the Agricultural Workers Wages Order 1960 is hereby revoked.
