Pursuant to the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1951, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration Fees Regulations 1952.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1952.
- 2. Regulation 1 of the regulations made under the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1924, dated the 7th day of December 1925, and published in the Gazette of the 21st day of January 1926 at page 146, is hereby revoked.
- 3. There shall be paid to the Registrar-General and to every Registrar for the various matters set out in the Schedule hereto the respective fees set out in the said Schedule.
