THE RIGHT HON. K. J. HOLYOAKE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1951, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration Fees Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Births and Deaths Registration Fees Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1954.

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by adding to the Schedule the following items:

“Registration of a change of name under section 17A, in respect of every person whose name has been changed:	£	s.	d.
“Where the birth has been registered in New Zealand	1	0	0
“Where the birth has not been registered in New Zealand	0	10	0”
