Pursuant to the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1951, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration Fees Regulations 1975.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 2nd day of June 1975.
- 2. Fees—There shall be paid to the Registrar-General and to every Registrar for the various matters set out in the Schedule to these regulations the respective fees specified in that Schedule.
- **3. Revocation**—The Births and Deaths Registration Fees Regulations 1967* are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 2 prescribes a new and increased scale of fees payable under the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1951 to the Registrar-General and to Registrars. The new scale comes into force on 2 June 1975.
