ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 10th day of May 1982

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 45 and 50 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1951, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration Regulations 1982.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1982.

2. Fees—There shall be paid to the Registrar-General and to every Registrar for the various matters set out in the Schedule to these regulations the respective fees specified in that Schedule.

3. Revocation—The Births and Deaths Registration Fees Regulations 1979* are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 2 prescribes a new and increased scale of fees payable under the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1951 to the Registrar-General and to Registrars. The new scale comes into force on 1 June 1982.
