ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 8th day of June 1987

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 45 and 50 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1951, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration (Fees) Regulations 1987.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1987.

**2. Fees**—There shall be paid to the Registrar-General or, as the case requires, to a Registrar, for each of the matters specified in the Schedule to these regulations, the fee specified for it in that Schedule.

**3. Amount of goods and services tax included**—The fees prescribed in these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

**4. Revocation**—The Births and Deaths Registration Fees Regulations 1986 are hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 1987, increase the fees payable under the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1951 to the Registrar-General and to Registrars, and make clear that the fees are inclusive of GST. There is also a new fee of \$5 for a photocopy of a pre-1900 entry.
