ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 45 and 50 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1951, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration (Fees) Regulations 1987.
 - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1987.
- 2. Fees—There shall be paid to the Registrar-General or, as the case requires, to a Registrar, for each of the matters specified in the Schedule to these regulations, the fee specified for it in that Schedule.
- **3.** Amount of goods and services tax included—The fees prescribed in these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.
- **4. Revocation**—The Births and Deaths Registration Fees Regulations 1986 are hereby revoked.

Births and Deaths Registration (Fees) Regulations 1987

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 1987, increase the fees payable under the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1951 to the Registrar-General and to Registrars, and make clear that the fees are inclusive of GST. There is also a new fee of \$5 for a photocopy of a pre-1900 entry.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936. Date of notification in *Gazette:* 11 June 1987. These regulations are administered in the Department of Justice.
