PURSUANT to the Boilers, Lifts, and Cranes Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Boilers and Machinery Exemption Order 1971.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Exemption**—The boilers and machinery referred to in the Schedule to this order are hereby exempted from the provisions of sections 10 to 16, and sections 18, 19, 21, and 23, and subsection (4) of section 28, and subsection (3) of section 29, of the Boilers, Lifts, and Cranes Act 1950, in so far as those provisions would apply to the boilers and machinery were it not for this order.

**SCHEDULE**

1. Boilers being used as vessels for compressed gas that are constructed, inspected, tested, and filled, to a standard approved by the Chief Surveyor, and that are being used exclusively for the transport of gas to New Zealand, if within 1 year from their arrival in New Zealand they are exported without being refilled.

2. Machinery which is driven solely by manual or animal power or the motive power of which does not exceed 1 horsepower.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*
