

THE BRAN AND POLLARD LEVY NOTICE 1956

PURSUANT to the Bran and Pollard Levy Regulations 1950* (hereinafter referred to as the regulations), the Minister of Industries and Commerce, after consultation with the Wheat Committee, hereby gives notice as follows:

- 1. This notice may be cited as the Bran and Pollard Levy Notice 1956, and shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1956.
- 2. The rate of levy on bran and pollard referred to in regulation 3 of the regulations is hereby fixed at 60s. on each ton of bran or pollard sold by or through the agency of the Wheat Committee.
 - 3. The Bran and Pollard Levy Notice 1955† is hereby revoked.
