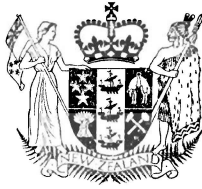

THE BRAN AND POLLARD LEVY NOTICE 1956

PURSUANT to the Bran and Pollard Levy Regulations 1950* (hereinafter referred to as the regulations), the Minister of Industries and Commerce, after consultation with the Wheat Committee, hereby gives notice as follows:

1. This notice may be cited as the Bran and Pollard Levy Notice 1956, and shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1956.

2. The rate of levy on bran and pollard referred to in regulation 3 of the regulations is hereby fixed at 60s. on each ton of bran or pollard sold by or through the agency of the Wheat Committee.

3. The Bran and Pollard Levy Notice 1955† is hereby revoked.
