

THE BUILDING CONSTRUCTION CONTROL NOTICE NO. 33

NOTICE is hereby given that, pursuant to the Supply Control Emergency Regulations 1939* and the Building Emergency Regulations 1939†, the Building Controller hereby requires and directs as follows:—

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Building Construction Control Notice No. 33.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 8th day of April 1953.

2. No owner, within the meaning of the Building Emergency Regulations 1939, of any new galvanized corrugated steel or iron sheets shall sell, supply, dispose of, or part with the possession or control of any of the sheets to any other person unless---

- (a) The owner first receives an application duly completed by that other person on a form approved by the Building Controller and provided for the purpose by the owner;
- (b) The application is submitted to and approved by the Building Controller or some person authorized by the Building Controller in that behalf; and
- (c) The owner forwards every such application to the Building Controller, P.O. Box 2293, Wellington, or as he directs, at such time as he directs:

Provided that nothing in this clause shall apply in any case where the owner is satisfied that the sheets are intended to be used for a purpose specified in clause 3 hereof.

3. Except with the precedent consent of the Building Controller, no person shall use new galvanized corrugated steel or iron sheets for any purpose other than—

- (a) The manufacture of supply tanks of 100-gallon capacity or more; or
- (b) The repair of existing galvanized corrugated steel or galvanized corrugated iron roofs of dwellings, but not including more than one repair of any one roof and not including in any case a total of more than one-fourth of the area of the existing roof.

4. In any case where an application has been made to any local authority, whether before or after the commencement of this notice, for a permit for any constructional work, the local authority shall not issue the permit therefor without the precedent consent of the Building Controller:

Provided that this clause shall not apply to such classes of constructional work as may from time to time be exempted by the Building Controller if the local authority complies with all conditions attached to the exemption, including the condition that the local authority shall furnish to the Building Controller such information and particulars at such times and in such form and manner as the Building Controller requires in relation to every case in which a permit is issued without the precedent consent of the Building Controller.

5. In any case where any person proposes to commence any constructional work and no permit therefor is required from a local authority, that person shall not commence the work without the precedent consent of the Building Controller unless the work is-

(a) Paperhanging or painting; or

(b) Work which is maintenance or replacement work or which relates only to fixtures and fittings and in which the value of the building-materials and labour required to be used does not exceed £500.

6. The Building Construction Control Notice No. 30,* the Building Construction Control Notice No. 31⁺, and the Building Construction Control Notice No. 32[‡] are hereby revoked.
