**THE BOBBY CALF MARKETING REGULATIONS 1939,
AMENDMENT NO. 2.**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 6th day of
August, 1941.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Marketing Act, 1936, and the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act, 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Bobby Calf Marketing Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 2.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Bobby Calf Marketing Regulations 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.†

4. The principal regulations are amended by inserting, next after Regulation 22 thereof, the following additional regulation :—

“ 22A. (i) Forthwith on the purchase (whether by way of public auction or otherwise) of any bobby calves, the purchaser shall prepare in duplicate a purchase-note which shall contain the particulars prescribed by clause (2) of this regulation, and shall forthwith deliver a copy of such note to the vendor, auctioneer, or other authorized agent of the vendor of the bobby calves comprised in the purchase.

“ (ii) Every purchase-note under this regulation shall contain the following particulars :—

- “ (a) The number of bobby calves comprised in the purchase ;
- “ (b) The name and address of the vendor of the bobby calves ;
- “ (c) The price or prices at which the bobby calves were purchased ;
and
- “ (d) If the bobby calves were raised or produced in a pool area,
the name of that pool area.

“(iii) The purchaser shall retain the duplicate copy of every purchase-note for a period of six months after the date of the purchase of the bobby calves to which the purchase-note relates, and the purchaser shall at any time during that period produce such purchase-note for inspection on demand by any officer of the Public Service duly authorized in that behalf by the Minister.”

5. Regulation 23 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, next after the word “balance-sheet” where that word first occurs therein, the words “in such form as the Minister approves or directs”.

6. The principal regulations are amended by inserting, next after Regulation 23 thereof, the following additional regulation :—

“23A. In addition to the balance-sheet required to be lodged by the Committee pursuant to the last preceding regulation the Committee shall at the same time deliver at the office of the said Division such statistics or other information or statement relating to the operations of the Committee as the Minister may from time to time require, and in such form as the Minister approves or directs.”

7. Clause 4 of the Schedule to the principal regulation is amended by revoking the first sentence thereof, and substituting the following :
“Any producer may by writing signed by him appoint his manager or his attorney (if any) or any member of his family, whether a producer or not, to be his proxy to vote on his behalf.”
