ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 29th day of July, 1942.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Marketing Act, 1936, and the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act, 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Bobby Calf Marketing Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Bobby Calf Marketing Regulations 1939.*

2. (1) The application of the Bobby Calf Marketing Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1[†], is hereby extended and the said amending regulations shall apply with respect to all bobby calves slaughtered at an abattoir or a meat-export slaughterhouse during the period of twelve months commencing on the 1st day of June, 1942.

(2) For the purposes of these regulations the reference to the **31st** day of May, 1942, in clause 10 (1) of the amending regulations hereinbefore referred to shall be read as a reference to the **31st** day of May, 1943.
