**THE BOBBY CALF MARKETING REGULATIONS 1955,  
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 10th day of November 1965

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dairy Production and Marketing Board Act 1961, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Bobby Calf Marketing Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Bobby Calf Marketing Regulations 1955\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definition of the term "Inspector", and substituting the following definition:

"'Inspector' means an Inspector under the Meat Act 1964 or an Inspector under the Stock Act 1908."

3. Regulation 40 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:

"(1) No person, whether as principal or agent, shall sell or offer for sale any bobby calf unless the calf has been properly and sufficiently fed daily from birth and has been so fed not earlier than the time of the commencement of the last milking of the herd of that person before the time of the actual removal of the calf from his premises in pursuance of a sale or a contract or intended contract of sale."

4. Regulation 40 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by inserting, after subclause (3), the following subclause:

“(3A) No person, whether as principal or agent, shall sell or offer for sale any bobby calf which appears to be unfit by reason of weakness or immaturity to be driven or conveyed to the place at which it is to be slaughtered.”

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

Regulation 2 substitutes a new definition of the term “Inspector”.

Regulation 3 provides that bobby calves offered for sale must be fed not earlier than the time of the commencement of the last milking of the owner's herd before the time of the removal of the calves for sale.

Regulation 4 provides that a bobby calf must not be sold or offered for sale if it appears to be unfit by reason of weakness or immaturity.
