## THE BUILDING EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 1.

# GALWAY, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 24th day of December, 1940.

### Present:

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Building Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1.
- (2) These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the Building Emergency Regulations 1939\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Regulation 1 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting in clause (3) thereof, after the definition of the term "Building materials," the following definition:—
  - "'Local authority' means the Council of any borough or of any county, the Board of any town district, or the Board of any road district situated within a county in which the Counties Act, 1920, is suspended or is not in force."
- 3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting next after Regulation 4 the following regulation:—
  - "REGULATION 4A.—DUTIES OF LOCAL AUTHORITIES.
- "(1) The Controller may from time to time direct, either generally or in respect of any special constructional work or class of constructional work, that no local authority shall issue any permit or consent in respect of any such constructional work without the precedent consent of the Controller. In any such case it shall be lawful for any local authority before accepting an application for a permit or consent

in respect of constructional work to require the applicant to supply to the local authority particulars as to the nature and quantity of the materials proposed to be used for the work or such other particulars as may be necessary to enable the local authority to determine whether the consent of the Controller is required.

"(2) In any case where the consent of the Controller is required under clause (1) of this regulation, any period of time prescribed under by-laws requiring an application for a permit or consent to be dealt with within a limited time shall cease to run during the period commencing on the date on which the application is referred to the Controller and expiring on the date on which the Controller's decision is

received by the local authority.

"(3) The Controller may from time to time direct, either generally or in respect of any special constructional work or class of constructional work, that local authorities which have issued or may after the date of such direction issue permits for such work shall furnish such information and particulars in relation thereto at such times and in such form and manner as the Controller thinks fit."
