## THE BREADMAKING INDUSTRY CONTROL ORDER 1943, AMENDMENT NO. 2

Pursuant to the Supply Control Emergency Regulations 1939,\* the Minister of Supply and Munitions doth hereby make the following Order.

## ORDER

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Breadmaking Industry Control Order 1943, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Breadmaking Industry Control Order 1943† (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).
- 2. This Order shall come into force on the 10th day of December, 1943.
- 3. Clause 4 of the principal Order is hereby amended by omitting the expression "6 oz.", and substituting the expression "3 oz.".
- **4.** Clause 7 of the principal Order is hereby amended by adding the words "together with the words 'If not available on request a 2 lb. white or wholemeal loaf must be supplied after due notice'".
