**THE BREADMAKING INDUSTRY CONTROL ORDER 1943,
AMENDMENT NO. 4**

PURSUANT to the Supply Control Emergency Regulations 1939, the Minister of Supply and Munitions doth hereby make the following Order.

ORDER

1. This Order may be cited as the Breadmaking Industry Control Order 1943, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Breadmaking Industry Control Order 1943* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. This Order shall come into force on the seventh day after the date of the notification thereof in the *Gazette*.

3. Clause 4 of the principal Order is hereby amended as follows :—

- (a) By omitting the word “ bake ” :
- (b) By omitting the words “ when baked ”.
