**THE BOILERS, LIFTS, AND CRANES (FEES) REGULATIONS
1951, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 6th day of August 1958

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Boilers, Lifts, and Cranes Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Boilers, Lifts, and Cranes (Fees) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Boilers, Lifts, and Cranes (Fees) Regulations 1951* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1958.

2. (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule thereto, as substituted by regulation 3 of the Boilers, Lifts, and Cranes (Fees) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 1, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Regulation 3 of the Boilers, Lifts, and Cranes (Fees) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 1, and the Schedule to those regulations are hereby revoked.
