PURSUANT to section 2 (2) of the Berryfruit Levy Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Berryfruit Levy Act Extension Order 1974.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1974.

2. Schedule extended—The Schedule to the Berryfruit Levy Act 1967 is hereby amended by inserting, after the words “cape gooseberries,” the words “hybrid blackberries from cultivated brambles,”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order adds hybrid blackberries from cultivated brambles to the list of berryfruit which is subject to the provisions of the Berryfruit Levy Act 1967.
