PURSUANT to the British Nationality and New Zealand Citizenship Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**O R D E R**

**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the British Nationality and New Zealand Citizenship Order 1972.

**2. Commonwealth country**—Bangladesh shall be deemed to be referred to in subsection (3) of section 3 of the British Nationality and New Zealand Citizenship Act 1948 (which subsection was substituted by section 2 of the British Nationality and New Zealand Citizenship Amendment Act 1965).

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order extends the list of Commonwealth countries in section 3 (3) of the British Nationality and New Zealand Citizenship Act 1948 so as to include Bangladesh.
