ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of July 1976

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the British Nationality and New Zealand Citizenship Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the British Nationality and New Zealand Citizenship Order 1976.

2. Commonwealth countries—Bahamas and Grenada shall be deemed to be referred to in subsection (3) of section 3 of the British Nationality and New Zealand Citizenship Act 1948 (which subsection was substituted by section 2 of the British Nationality and New Zealand Citizenship Amendment Act 1965).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order extends the list of Commonwealth countries in section 3 (3) of the British Nationality and New Zealand Citizenship Act 1948 to include Bahamas and Grenada.
