PURSUANT to the British Nationality and New Zealand Citizenship Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the British Nationality and New Zealand Citizenship Order (No. 2) 1967.

2. Lesotho, Barbados, and Botswana shall be deemed to be referred to in subsection (3) of section 3 of the British Nationality and New Zealand Citizenship Act 1948, which subsection was substituted by section 2 of the British Nationality and New Zealand Citizenship Amendment Act 1965.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order extends the list of Commonwealth countries in section 3 (3) of the British Nationality and New Zealand Citizenship Act 1948 so as to include Lesotho, Barbados, and Botswana.
