ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 5 and 504 of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Bay of Plenty Harbour Board Flag Regulations 1986.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Marine flag of Bay of Plenty Harbour Board—The flag described in the Schedule to these regulations is hereby declared to be the marine flag of the Bay of Plenty Harbour Board.
- **3. Wearing of flag by ships of Board**—The marine flag of the Bay of Plenty Harbour Board may be worn by ships (being New Zealand ships) owned and operated by the Board within the internal waters and territorial sea of New Zealand.

4. Revocation—The Bay of Plenty Harbour Board Flag Regulations 1970* are hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

MARINE FLAG OF THE BAY OF PLENTY HARBOUR BOARD

A blue flag with a canton of the New Zealand Flag and on the fly the shield of the Armorial Bearings of the Bay of Plenty Harbour Board granted by Letters Patent dated 21 September 1982, that is to say, Per Chevron Argent and Vert on a base Argent three Bars wavy Azure in chief four Mullets in cross Gules between two Lymphads addorsed sails furled oars in action Sable the castles at prow and stern Or Flags and Pennants Azure and in the Vert eleven Bezants two four and five.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations revoke and replace the Bay of Plenty Harbour Board Flag Regulations 1970. They alter the design of the marine flag of the Bay of Plenty Harbour Board, and specify the conditions in which ships owned by the Board may wear the flag.
