REGULATIONS 1944, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the provisions of section 26 of the Board of Trade Act, 1919, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, and deeming the provisions hereinafter contained to be necessary in the public interest for divers of the purposes set out in the said section, doth hereby make the following regulations for the purposes of the said Act.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Board of Trade (Wheat and Flour) Regulations 1944, Amendment No. 2.
2. These regulation shall be read with and form part of the Board of Trade (Wheat and Flour) Regulations 1944* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
3. Regulation 66 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the amount “ $\frac{5}{8}$ d.”, and substituting therefor the amount “1d.”.
4. Regulation 67 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the amount “ $\frac{1}{2}$ d.”, and substituting therefor the amount “ $\frac{3}{4}$ d.”.
5. Regulation 125 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, after the word “purchase” where first used, the word “transport”.

6. Regulation 228 of the principal regulations (as heretofore amended by Regulation 6 of the Board of Trade (Wheat and Flour) Regulations Amendment No. 1) is further amended by revoking the amount "1s. 1d." wherever it appears, and substituting therefor the amount "1s. 2d."

7. Regulation 229 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking paragraph (ii) thereof, and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

"(ii) Flour sold otherwise than in sacks containing 160 lb."
